## Overview

The **Clearlogin Password Manager** (CPM) is an app extension that gets installed into your internet browser. The CPM is used to securely store your credentials (usernames and passwords) for the websites that require you to login each time you visit them.

Currently, the CPM is available for Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, and the new Microsoft Edge (via the Chrome web store).

## Installation Requirements

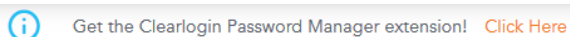
- A supported Internet browser: Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, or Microsoft Edge.
- Applicable permissions on your computer to install the CPM extension into your browser.

## Installation Steps

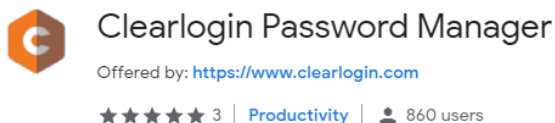
Select your browser name below to expand the installation instructions.

### Install in Google Chrome

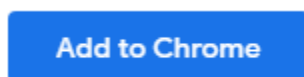
- After signing into your Clearlogin company portal, you should see a banner at the top reminding you to get the CPM extension.



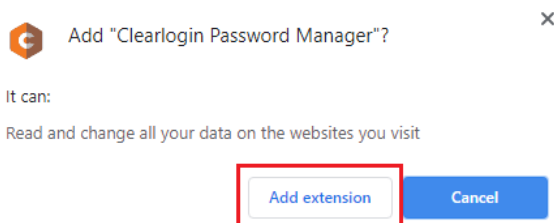
- When you click on the link, a new tab will open in your browser showing you the Chrome Web Store.



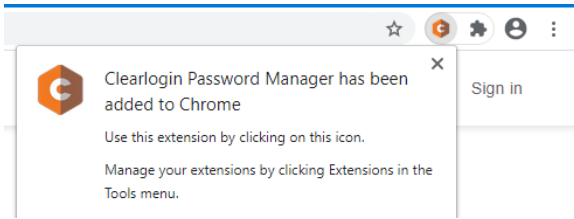
- Click the **Add to Chrome** button to install the CPM extension.



- In the confirmation pop-up box, click the **Add Extension** button.



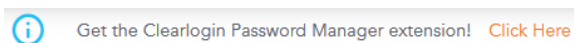
- After the CPM extension is successfully installed, you will see the ...**added to Chrome** message.

### Install in Mozilla Firefox

- After signing into your Clearlogin company portal, you should see a banner at the top reminding you to get the CPM extension.



- When you click on the link, a new tab will open in your browser showing you the Firefox Add-On Store. Click the **Add to Firefox** button.

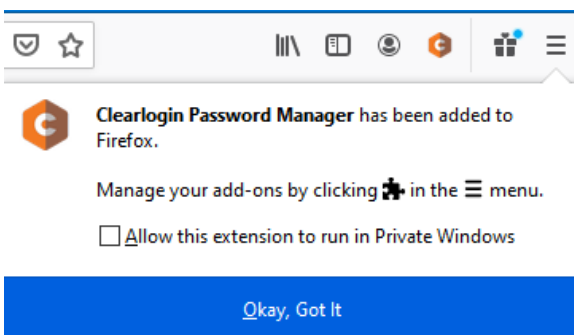

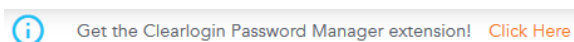
- After the CPM extension is successfully installed, you will see the . . .**added to Firefox** message.

- When you click on the link, a new tab will open in your browser showing you the Chrome Web Store.

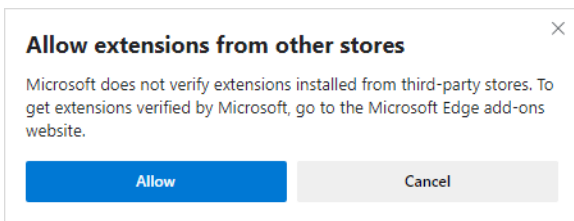
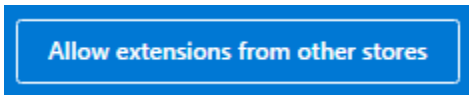

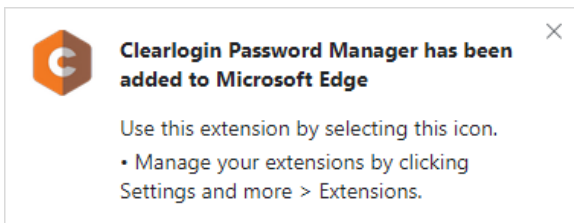
- After the page refreshes, click the **Add to Chrome** button to install the CPM extension.
