

Delete a Catalog


You can delete a catalog from your organization.


Prerequisites

This operation requires the rights included in the predefined **Catalog Author** or an equivalent set of rights.

Note: The catalog must not contain any vApp templates or media files. You need to delete the items from the catalog before you can remove it.

Procedure

1. On the **Virtual Datacenters** dashboard screen, click the card of the virtual data center you want to explore.
2. From the main menu select **Libraries** and select **Catalogs** from the left panel.
 - a. Verify that there are no vApp Templates or Media in the Catalog, if there are you will be unable to delete the Catalog.
3. Click  next to the catalog you want to remove and click **Delete**.
4. Confirm the deletion.
